**PLANNING**

**18/01019 – Woodmans Cottage, Hill Lane** – erection of garage and wood store. There were no objections to this application, proposed to support Cllr Hickey, seconded Cllr Speed, all in favour

**18/01103 – Nosterns Well, Netherton Lane** – American style stable barn – whilst Cllrs were in full agreement that there were no objections to the size and purpose of the building, concerns were raised with regard the location – being too prominent and its close proximity to the highway. It was agreed that comments to WDC should record to this effect. Proposed Cllr Axtell-Powell, seconded Cllr Douglas – all in favour

**18/01604 – Nosterns Well, Netherton Lane** – free standing single storey 4-bay garage – following a site visit, Cllrs were advised that changes to the application had been made, reducing to a 3-bay garage with the construction to be a combination of brick and timber. There were no objections to this application, proposed Cllr Hickey, seconded Cllr Speed – all in favour

**18/01172 – 17 Cornmill Close, Elmley Castle** -single storey rear extension – there were no objections to this application, proposed Cllr K Mackison, seconded Cllr Strong – all in favour.

**OTHER BUSINESS FOR DISCUSSION**

**Grass Cutting, Playing Field** – two quotes had been sought for the cutting of the entrance to the playing field and football pitches, one for £80 and the second for £60. It was agreed we go with the lower of the 2 quotes (Smartcut) but it was suggested that the Cricket Club should be making a contribution for use of the field.
