**2. APOLOGIES** were received from Cllrs J Douglas and S Speed

**3. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST** – Cllr J Strong – The Queens Public House

**4. TO DISCUSS:**

- Retaining The Queens as an Asset of Community Value – which is due to expire on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2019 – discussion took place and it was agreed that the Parish Council should re-apply for The Queens to remain an Asset of Community Value. Proposed Cllr Hickey, seconded Cllr Thomson.

*Since the meeting the clerk has been advised by WDC, that although the parish council were only contacted at the end of January with regard the expiry of the current 'registration' on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2019, we should in fact have made the new application several months prior (November/December 2018) to have enabled continuity. This is to enable checks with the Land Registry to be completed, and for the new application to be considered by Wychavon's own 'in-house' committee. The clerk questioned the fact that we were only notified at the end of January, being too late for continuity of the 'registration' but there was nothing that could be done*
