

The name of the Charity shall be the ELMLEY CASTLE PLAYING FIELD AND RECREATION GROUND or any such name as the Trustee from time to time by resolution may decide with the prior approval of the Charity Commissioner.

Trustee – The body Corporate called Elmley Castle, Bricklehampton and Netherton Parish Council.

THE SCHEDULE

1. The land hereby assured (hereinafter referred to as the land) shall as far as practicable be forever used and maintained as a Children's Playing Field and Recreation Ground for the use of the children of Elmley Castle and District but if, in the opinion of the Trustee, the whole of the land is not required for use as a Children's Playing Field and Recreation Ground, the Trustee may permit the use of such part thereof, as they shall think fit, as a playing field and recreation ground for adults of Elmley Castle and District aforesaid
2. The iron gate at the main entrance and other ironwork thereto and the pillars and foundations supporting the same together with any other gates and the present and any future fences shall always be maintained in good order and condition.
3. The pathway leading to and in the land shall be kept in a tidy good and safe condition. The shrubs at the main entrance shall be kept in good condition and renewed whenever necessary.
4. The Trustee shall make safe and suitable arrangements whereby children and adults can use the land for playing and recreation and to set out the land as may be required for this purpose.
5. Facilities shall be given to children and adults to play games and such games shall be free of charge and also full and proper provision shall be made for the recreation and welfare of children and adults without payment of charge. Any reasonable charge for use of or admission to the land shall be at the sole discretion of the Trustee.
6. The Swings, Chute Plank or Boat Wheel, Joy Wheel or Revolving Platform and such like together with the foundations and surface thereof and appliances used in connection therewith shall be kept in a good safe and working condition.
7. No building shall be erected other than those necessary for supervision and for the use and development of the land as a Playing Field and Recreation Ground.
8. No horses, cows, rams or dogs (except on leash) shall be allowed on the land.
9. The Trustee shall make provision whereby paper and any rubbish which may be thrown or scattered on any part of the land shall be promptly collected and disposed of.
10. The Trustee shall as far as practicable make provision to prevent rough, violent or boisterous games to be indulged in and shall prevent any noisy or disorderly conduct and any other practice likely to prevent the use by the children and adults of the land for the purposes aforesaid.
11. No timber shall be felled except such as may have to be removed by reason of decay or for the proper laying out of the land as a Children and Adult's Playing Field and Recreation Ground
12. No portion of the mines or minerals under the land shall be worked or removed.
