Scheme.

SCHEME MADE BY THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION UNDER THE CHARITABLE TRUSTS ACTS, 1853 TO 1925.

Variation of Trusts.

1. The Deed of 1 February 1932 now regulating the Charity called the Children's Playing Field and Recreation Ground at Elmley Castle in the County of Worcester shall have effect with the following variations :—

- (a) The addition of the following words at the end of clause 1 of the Schedule thereto :—
 " but if, in the opinion of the County Council, the whole of the land is not required for use as a Children's Playing Field and Recreation Ground, the County Council may permit the use of such part thereof, as they shall think fit as a playing field and recreation ground for adults of Elmley Castle and District aforesaid."
- (b) The addition of the words " and adults " after the word " children " where it occurs in clauses 4, 5, 12 and 13 of the said Schedule thereto.
- (c) The omission of clauses 15 and 16 of the said Schedule thereto.
- (d) The omission of the word " Children's " from the name of the Foundation.

Questions under the Scheme.

2. Any question as to the construction of this Scheme, or as to the regularity or the validity of any acts done or about to be done under this Scheme, shall be determined conclusively by the Minister of Education upon such application made to him for the purpose as he thinks sufficient.

Interpretation.

3. The Interpretation Act, 1889, applies to the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

Date of Scheme.

4. The date of this Scheme shall be the day on which it is established by an Order of the Minister of Education.

The Minister of Education orders that the foregoing Scheme be established.
