CHARITY COMMISSION

In the matter of the Charity called The Playing field and Recreation Ground at Elmley Castle, In the County of Hereford and Worcester regulated by deed of gift dated 1st February 1932 as varied by a Scheme made by the Minister of Education on the 28th October 1950; and
In the matter of the Charities Act 1993.

THE CHARITY COMMISSIONERS FOR ENGLAND AND WALES HEREBY ORDER that the following Scheme be approved and established:-.

S C H E M E

1. Administration of Charity. (1) The above-mentioned Charity and the property thereof specified in the schedule hereto and all other the property (if any) of the Charity shall be administered and managed subject to and in accordance with the provisions of the above-mentioned deed of gift and Scheme as varied or affected by the provisions of this Scheme by the Trustee hereinafter appointed.

(2) The name of the Charity shall be the Elmley Castle Playing Field and Recreation Ground or such other name as the Trustee from time to time by resolution may decide with the prior approval of the Charity Commissioners.

2. Vesting. The land specified in the said schedule is hereby vested in the Trustee hereinafter appointed for all the estate and interest therein belonging to or held in trust for the Charity.

3. Trustee. The body corporate called Elmley Castle Bricklehampton and Netherton Parish Council shall be the Trustee of the Charity.

4. Questions under Scheme. Any question as to the construction of this Scheme or as to the regularity or the validity of any acts done or about to be done under this Scheme shall be determined by the Commissioners upon such application made to them for the purpose as they think sufficient.

SCHEDULE

Land situate at Elmley Castle in the County of Hereford and Worcester and having a frontage on the South on the road leading from Elmley Castle to Kersoe being the land comprised in a deed of gift dated 1st February 1932 and made between Ernest Stevens of the one part and the County Council of Worcestershire of the other part.
