6. TREES:

Proposal to authorise up to a maximum of £2,000 to complete the following treework in the Parish:

1. Trim lower branches of trees around the playing field / cricket pitch. These branches are impairing the growth of the grass beneath.
2. Trimming of trees & shrubbery in Millend, Elmley Castle.
3. Trimming and possible felling of a self seeding tree at the entrance to the playing fields from Main Street that is encroaching towards a neighbouring property which is likely to cause damage to the roof.
